Exchange Student Program

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The objective of the exchange student program for students from our partner universities is to provide international exchange students with the opportunity to acquire the experience of living and studying in our campus. It aims at promoting international exchanges in education and mutual friendship between the universities.

QUALIFICATIONS

Prospective applicant must meet the following qualification criteria:

1. Must be a student of HBNU's partner university.
2. Have an adequate health, both physically and mentally.
3. You have the academic background related to the course you are applying for.

DURATION OF STAY

Students may choose to enroll for one semester or one year of the study program under the agreement between two universities.

ACADEMIC CALEDAR

Semester 1 – The first week of March until Mid June

Semester 2 – The first week of September until Mid December

SUBMISSION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Applications from exchange students must be approved by and submitted through the international office of one of HBNU's partner universities.

2. Deadline of Submission
 - Semester 1 (March intake) – Dec 18
 - Semester 2 (August intake) – June 15
3. Documents to be submitted
 - ①. One Application Form (as prescribed)

- ②. One Copy of Certificate of Enrollment
- ③. One Copy of Transcript
- ④. One Recommendation Letter from the relevant chief executive officer of the organization
- ⑤. One Copy of Passport
- ⑥. For Chinese only: A Copy of Household Register(常住人口登錄簿)
- ⑦. Two Photos (3.5x4.5cm)

ACCOMODATION

****The exchange students will stay at Nurihall(Off campus).**

Housing with convenient facilities will be provided for international students during their stay. Around 1,200 students from local and foreign countries are occupied at two dormitories on campus, 5 minutes away from main campus on foot and over 56

students stay at Nuri Hall located off campus, 20 minutes away from main campus by bus.

1) On-campus dormitory

HBNU has two apartment-typed dormitories and two studio-typed dormitories. Apartment-typed dormitory consists of three rooms in one section and each room accommodates 2 persons respectively. The occupants share a big lounge and a bathroom. The studio-typed dormitory provides one room for two persons. They have his/her own bed, space to study and plenty of storage.

All dormitories provide on-site laundry, free internet access, fitness center, computer lab and reading room. Three meals per day for one week are generally provided to all the dormitory residents during their stay. Parking is also available. HBNU housing is ready to make students feel at home.

2) Off-campus dormitory

Prospective students can also choose to stay in Nuri Hall(2persons in one room) with international students from seven different universities located in Daejeon. Nuri hall is designated to accommodate international students only and provides on-site laundry, free internet access, fitness center and sharing kitchen, as you will be sharing the cooking with your house mates. Two students will be placed in one room. Each room has two beds, a bathroom, a place to study and plenty of storage.

KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

For students who are not proficient in Korean Language, Center for International Exchange provides Korean Language Intensive courses.

- ①. Exchange students who intend to study at HBNU from Fall semester of 2017 must arrive in Korea before March 2nd, 2017.

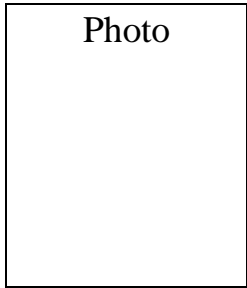
