Infection Prevention Measures for the Winter Break and University Entrance Exam

The University of Fukui has been taking measures to prevent the spread of infection in line with "Student Action Guidelines for Preventing COVID-19 Infection" (hereinafter referred as "Student Action Guidelines") and the President's Notices. Although the infection situation has calmed down nationwide, please brace yourself and take proper actions not to get infected nor to infect others. I ask each one of you to pay attention to the following items and take proper actions:

## 1. COVID-19 Infection Prevention

Make sure to follow the Student Action Guidelines and take thorough infection prevention measures such as wearing a mask, avoiding the 3Cs, and hand washing.

Parties should only be held and attended by a small number of people (4 people per table is recommended), and those who participate should have completed their two vaccinations except for those who have special reasons (such as people with allergies or other pre-existing conditions).

#### 2. Classes after the Winter Break

Basically, classes after the winter break will be offered via the Internet as below as an infection prevention measure for the university entrance exam. Some classes may be offered in person depending on the policies of each school, but please make sure to check the website of each school or graduate school and the student portal.

Distance Lectures Period: From 5th January (Wed.) to 13th January (Thu.)

Refrain from coming on campus unless absolutely necessary From 14<sup>th</sup> January (Fri.) to 16<sup>th</sup> January (Fri)

Coming on campus is prohibited for the university exam

## **3**. Extracurricular Activities during the Winter Break

Although extracurricular activities are allowed within the alert levels indicated in "Guidelines for the Phased Deregulation of Extracurricular Activities for Students at the University of Fukui" (Attachment 2), all activities on Bunkyo Campus are prohibited from 27<sup>th</sup> December 2021 to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022. As for Matsuoka Campus, we will let you know later. After 17<sup>th</sup> Jan (Mon.), activities will be allowed within the alert levels indicated in the guidelines.

Activities outside the campus are allowed within the alert levels indicated in the guidelines.

**4**. In case you are diagnosed with COVID-19, or have close contact with someone else who is, during the winter break.

In case you are diagnosed with COVID-19, or have close contact with someone else who is, follow the instructions of the Public Health Center. In addition, send an e-mail to the contact address below and submit the history of your activities for the last 2 weeks (dates, times, places, activities, people with whom you had contact).

If you have any cold symptoms, such as a fever, cough, or general malaise, consult with your family doctor or the nearest medical institution first. If you do not have any family doctor, consult with the "Consultation Center" of your own city or town. In the case of Fukui prefecture, they can offer some support on the phone (0776-20-0795).
