Entering Campus after the Winter Break and the University Entrance Exam

Since the Year-end and New Year holidays, community-acquired infection with the highly infectious Omicron variant has been confirmed nationwide, and the infection is spreading rapidly. Infections of COVID-19 originating from outside Fukui prefecture have also been spreading in the prefecture, and there is concern about the rapid spread of infection in Fukui.

I would like to ask all students to brace yourselves and take thorough infection-prevention measures such as wearing a mask properly, hand washing, health monitoring, and refraining from parties. If you feel unusual, such as having a fever, consult with your family doctor or the nearest medical institution first. If you do not have any family doctor or do not know whom to consult, contact the consulting line of the Fukui Prefecture "Consultation Center," TEL: (0776)-20-0795 (callers will be guided to a cell phone number outside the opening hours). (If you are outside Fukui, contact the consultation service in your place of residence).

If you move to/from other prefectures, make sure to be back in Fukui at least 3 days before entering campus, avoid person-to-person contact, stay home and monitor your health condition as much as possible. In addition, if each school or graduate school gives directions, please obey them.

You are able to take a free PCR test for residents of Fukui prefecture if you are concerned about the possibility of COVID-19 infection, such as in case you are unable to receive vaccinations for health reasons, returned home from outside the prefecture after the New Year holidays, or have had a meal in Fukui prefecture with family or friends who then returned to their homes outside the prefecture.
