Course Description

In this course, the students' previously learned Chinese language skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing will be linked organically to foster an overall set of Chinese communication skills that are needed for daily life, education, the workplace, and other situations. Native speakers of Chinese will teach this course in Chinese while leading the students through practical situations that they may encounter. Students will also standardize their pronunciation and learn more vocabulary and complex grammatical patterns. The aim of this course is to bring the students' applied Chinese language skills to Level 4 (intermediate) on the Chinese Language Proficiency Test (Chuken) and to Level 3 (high) on the *Hanyu shuiping kaoshi* (HSK).
