Course Description

Building upon Practical Chinese I, this course will attempt further integration of students' skills in speaking, listening to, reading, and writing Chinese. Instructors who are native speakers of Chinese will conduct the course in Chinese. Students will acquire the natural Chinese expressions needed for communication in practical situations. Along with acquiring basic communication skills for daily life, education, work, and other situations, they will be able to handle most situations they encounter while traveling in China. The course aims to bring students to Level 4 (high) on the Chinese Language Proficiency Test (Chuken) and to Level 4 (low) on the *Hanyu shuiping kaoshi* (HSK).
