1. About VISA and Alien Registration Card

1.1 How to get Korea VISA

Exchange Students should apply for D-2 VISA for entering Korea.

You can get VISA at Korean embassy with the Certificate of Admission and other materials that Korean embassy demands in each country.

1.2 Alien Registration Card Application

- 1) Period : You should register in 2weeks after arriving Korea
- 2) Place : Busan Immigration Office
- 3) Material : consolidated application(designated form), passport, documents of proof of stay, certificate of enrollment, physical examination paper, photo(white background), processing fee(KRW 30,000)
- 4) Acceptance of Alien Registration Card: Early April (subject to change)

2. Arrivals

2.1 Date of Arrival: Feb. 23th(Sat) ~ Feb. 24th(Sun), 2019

※ You can't enter Dormitory before Feb. 23th, 2019

2.2 Pick up Service

※ We can provide pick up service Feb. 23th ~ Feb. 24th, 2019

※ If you want to apply pick up service, please let me know your flight schedule via e-mail(j73071426@dau.ac.kr) before Feb. 3rd, 2019

3. Accommodation & Meals

3.1 The dorm rooms will be randomly assigned and all of the exchange students must live in Hanlim dormitory in Seunghak Campus.

3.2 Dormitory Fee : Seunghak Campus [(amount for a semester(4 months)]

- Male students(New dorm) : about KRW 821,900

- Female students(Old dorm) : about KRW 721,600

※ According to the sister univ. agreement, it is possible to waive the dormitory fee.

3.3 Room Type : double occupancy only

3.4 Facilities : bathroom, desk, chair, air-conditioning and heating equipment etc

3.5 Blanket and pillow will not be provided.

3.6 There are three types(A type : 110 meal tickets, B type : 90 meal tickets, C type : 70 meal tickets, KRW 3,500 per ticket) of meal tickets and they are available in the dormitory cafeteria at student's own expense. The meal ticket can be used only for breakfast and dinner and the students must purchase separate ticket for lunch separately.

3.7 After student check-in to the dorm, It is required to watch the on-line guideline about the regulations of the dormitory by early September.

4. Medical Examination

4.1 Need to have a medical examination to enter the dormitory and apply Alien Registration Card.

4.2 Check-up fee is about KRW 11,000 ~ 12,000.

5. Course Information

5.1 Major Course

- 1) Period : Mar. 4th ~ Jun. 19th, 2019
- 2) Course enrollment : Sep. 6th ~ Sep. 7th, 2018

5.2 Korean Language Course

- 1) Period : Mar. 4th ~ Jun. 19th, 2019
- 2) Tuition fee may be waived or not be waived according to the agreement of both parties.
- 3) Class Hour : Intermediate/Advanced(09:00-13:00), Basic(13:10-17:10)
- 4) Credit : 20 credits
- 5) Major course and Korean language course cannot be overlapped.

6. Insurance

Students enrolled at DAU are required to purchase and maintain adequate health insurance coverage while participating in the program. If you have bought insurance in your country for Study Abroad, it's not essential.

※ Insurance Fee : KRW 80,000 per semester, KRW 130,000 per year

7. Buddy Program(DAILY)

Buddy program(Daily) is joined by volunteer students who are currently studying at DAU. Daily is to provide a friendly assistance to newly-arriving exchange students so than they can fit in the campus environment and life in Busan much easily. Daily will support exchange students in so many different ways, including:

- 1) Meeting you upon arrival at the airport and helping check in dormitory
- 2) Showing you around the university and helping you register courses
- 3) Helping make Alien Registration Card and medical examination
- 4) Introducing Korean life(buying mobile, transportation, etc)
- 5) Providing guidance about announcements from the dormitory, student cultural experience from office of international affairs etc

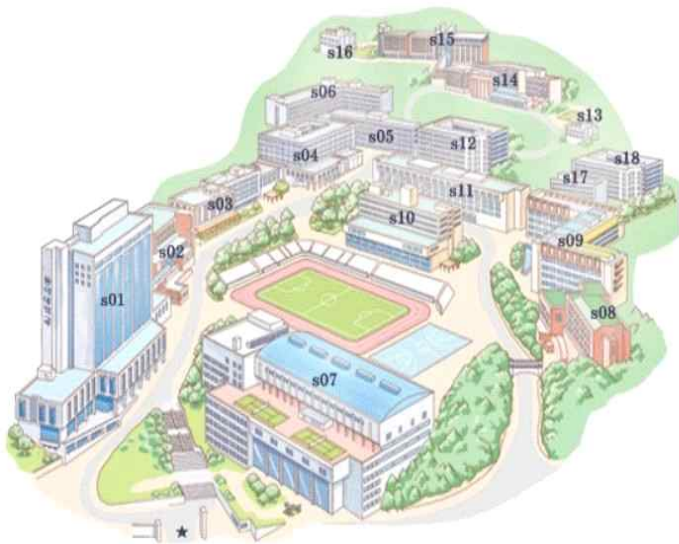

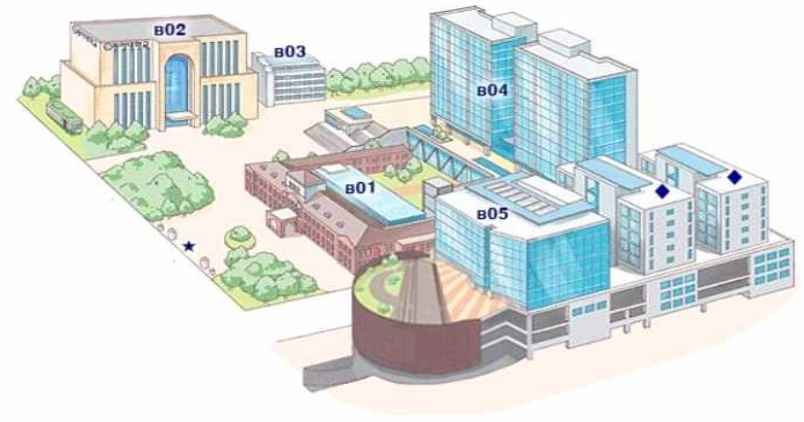

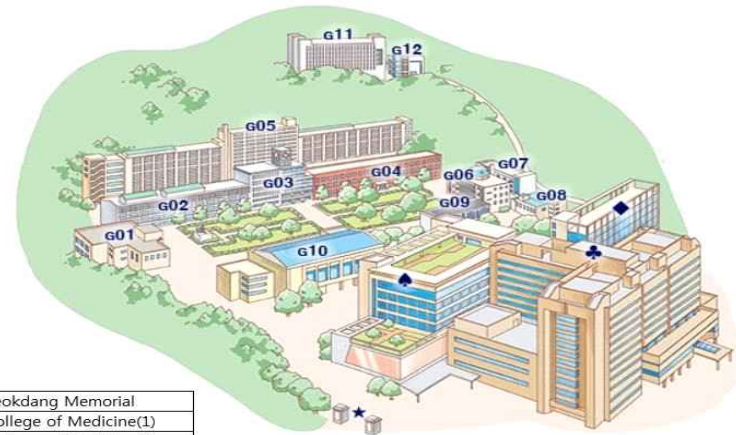

from Busan International Airport to DAU(Seunghak Campus)

1. 버스 Bus

- 장소(Place) : 3번 출구(Gate 3)
- 13번 마을버스 탑승(공항-하단 지하철역)
Take No.13 Bus(Airport-Hadan Subway Station)
- 약 40분 소요되며, 요금은 1,300원입니다. It takes approx. 40 minute.(KRW 1,300)
- 하단지하철 역 6번 출구에서 동아대학교 버스를 이용(무료)
Take School Bus to Campus(Dormitory) at Hadan Subway Gate 6.(No charge)

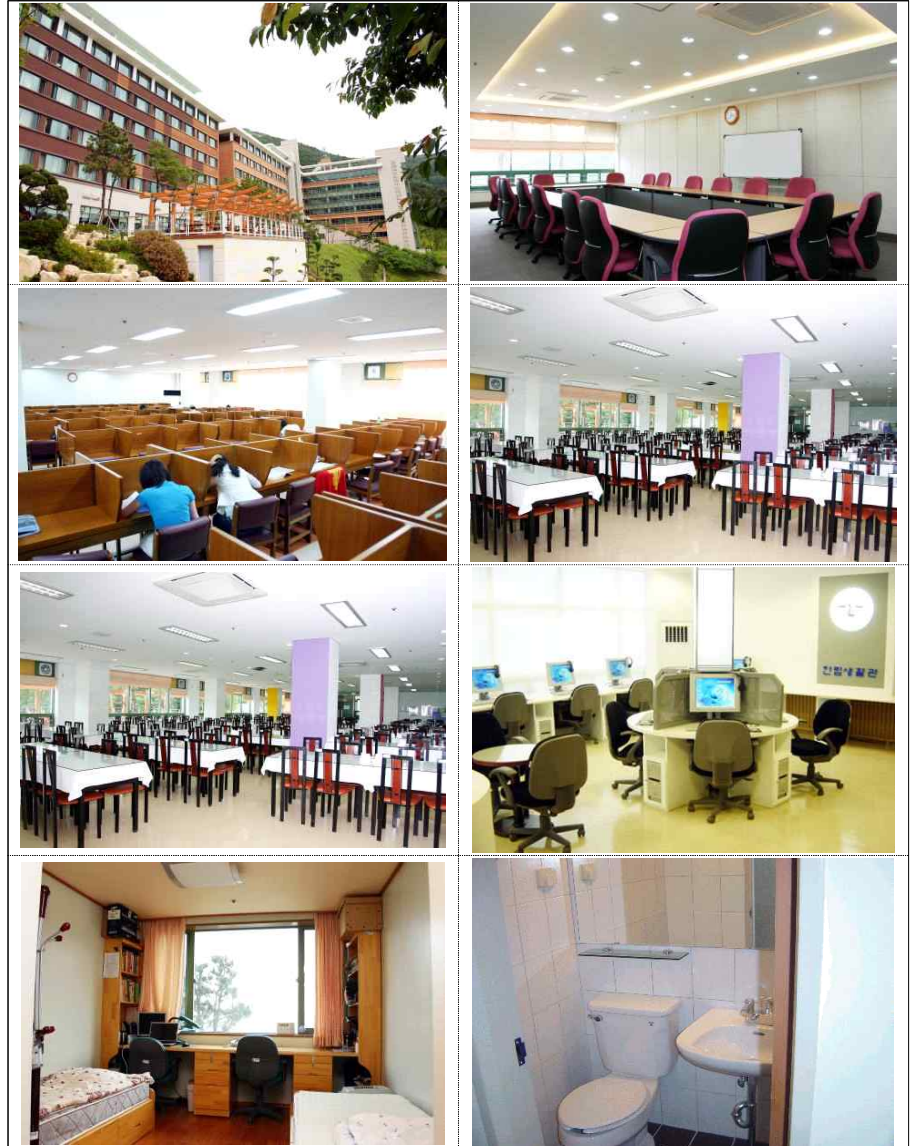
2. 택시 Taxi

한림생활관(Hanlim Dormitory)

Hanlim dormitory has been in operation since 2002 to create a more convenient life for students and provide a space for comfort and relaxation. The new dormitory is opened in 2016. For the comfort and convenience of students, there are lounges, laundry rooms, gym, reading rooms, an Internet cafe, meeting rooms, well equipped showers and washrooms, and high-speed LAN cable.





부산 소개 (Introduction of Busan Metropolitan City)

Busan, a bustling city of approximately 3.6 million residents, is located on the southeastern tip of the Korean peninsula. The size of Busan is 769.82km² which is 0.8% of the whole land of the Korean Peninsula. The natural environment of Busan is a perfect example of harmony between mountains, rivers and sea. Its geography includes a coastline with superb beaches and scenic cliffs, mountains which provide excellent hiking and extraordinary views, and hot springs scattered throughout the city. Busan enjoys four distinct seasons and a temperate climate that never gets too hot or too cold.

Busan is the second largest city in Korea. Its deep harbor and gentle tides have allowed it to grow into the largest container handling port in the country and the fifth largest in the world. The city's natural endowments and rich history have resulted in Busan's increasing reputation as a world class city of tourism and culture, and it is also becoming renowned as an international convention destination.

1. Location

Geographically, Busan has the Straits of Korea to its south Ulsan to the north, Gimhae to the West. Cities that share almost the same latitude with Busan include Jinhae and Gwangju in Korea, as well as Tokyo, Jeongsen, Algiers and Oklahoma City abroad. Busan is eight hours ahead of GMT. As for its geopolitical location, the city comes at the Southern tip of a strip that connects Asia, Siberia and Europe. It also serves as a main gateway to the Pacific Ocean. This location places the city at the center of international sea transportation.



2. Climate

Busan is located at the southeastern most tip of the Korean peninsula and in the mid-latitude temperate zone, which has seasonal winds. It has four seasons : Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter. The annual average temperature is 15° C. The annual average precipitation is 1,168.3mm. Busan has strong winds compared to other areas in Korea. Spring begins in March and ends in late June. Cherry blossom trees bloom in late March. and the temperature is very comfortable in April, May and June. The rainy season at the

end of June and July signals the beginning of the coming of the summer heat. The highest mean temperatures of around 32° C are at the end of July through mid-August. Fall is from early September through late-November. The weather is nice and cool at this time because of the continental high atmospheric pressure. Winter starts by the end of November and continues until February. but Busan rarely has any snowfalls. The average winter temperature is 3.8° C. Tourists can enjoy Busan throughout all seasons because of the nice weather and beautiful scenery. In summer, the city is crowded with visitors who come to enjoy the beautiful beaches.

3. Population

From its opening in 1876, the port city of Busan quickly developed into a hub of trade, commerce and industry. This development resulted in a rapid increase in its population, which had already reached 200,000 by 1936. A major leap in Busan's population came with the breakout of the Korean War, which resulted in an endless stream of people into the city. As a result, the population of Busan exceeded 1 million by the end of 1955. Another factor that spurred the population increase was the government policy for economic growth. People from urban areas kept streaming into the city for jobs. By the end of 1994, there were approximately 4 million people who called Busan their home. Since 1995, the population has slowly begun to decrease. As of December 2017, Busan was home to 3,539,532 people.

4. Busan Citizen's Character

The city of Busan, beautifully situated beside the Nakdong River and Mt. Geumjong, continues the fair and equitable spirit of the Gaya and Shilla cultures with a keen vision for furthering national self-esteem and the cultivation of democracy. Busan, located at the very heart of Northeast Asia, is the maritime gate to the Asia-Pacific rim group nations and serves as a major bridgehead to the Northeast Asian continent. Busan is widely open to talented people in every field of human endeavor. We are proud to be citizens of Busan. We will open up the bright future of our city with a dynamic spirit that contributes to the prosperity of Busan, to the nation as a whole and to the general welfare of mankind.
