授業概要 Course summary

This course aims to introduce students to some representative English Literature. The main goal is to achieve an understanding and appreciation of the literature: its art, style and language as well as simply the stories. The literature also gives an insight into England's history and culture, which can then be used as the basis for valuable intercultural interaction. Literature inspires us to think and reading improves English skills: reading, vocabulary building, and grammar. Reading also has a positive influence on writing, so there will be some writing, too.

到達目標 Course goal

Students should develop an appreciation and understanding of some representative English Literature from different eras while also developing their English language ability. All 4 skills (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) will be used extensively, so those skills should improve. In addition, students' reflective and critical thinking skills should develop as they benefit from extensive intercultural interaction, and they should be able to personalize their learning to make it meaningful for them and refine their abilities to see things from multiple perspectives.

授業内容 Course description

Each class will begin with a timed reading from English or American Literature. This will be followed by a student presentation, introducing a famous work/writer. Then, we will study the main novels. We will study the novels in the following ways:

- 1) Mini-lectures
- 2) Photocopied extracts of key passages from original novels and Information Exchanges with other students
- 3) Watching movie adaptations
- 4) Discussion questions (pairs/groups, worksheets)

In classes 1 to 8, we will study Dickens' *A Christmas Carol*. In classes 9 to 15, we will study Hornby's *About a Boy*. Class 16 will be the final test.

- 2) Read next chapters of literature at home & prepare notes & questions to lead/join discussion in next class
- 3) Instructor-students/students-students engage in discussions; Instructor facilitates study of next chapters
