授業概要 Course summary
<p>This course aims to build students' English conversation/communication skills, improving their ability to think and communicate in English. Each week, we'll do some communication task activities, using the textbook and supplementary materials. These activities allow for free/open-ended responses that should serve to draw on the students' own experiences, ideas, and opinions, thus leading to greater fluency. Also, the textbook provides good listening and speaking practice. The textbook is published by Oxford University Press, and the videos are made by BBC Worldwide Learning. In addition, each student will give a presentation to the class (either individually or in a pair) on a topic from the textbook.</p>
到達目標 Course goal
<p>This goal of this course is to build students' English conversation/communication skills, improving their ability to think and communicate in English. The goal is for students to engage in increasingly extended discourse with greater fluency and confidence. There will be many opportunities to watch and listen to authentic English conversation and many opportunities for students to express themselves (their ideas and opinions) extensively in English.</p>
授業内容 Course description
<p>Each week, we will cover 1 sub-unit from the textbook. It contains units on various topics (e.g. food, families, personalities, money, transport, gender, manners, sports, relationships, movies, education, housing, work, shopping, electrical devices, and idols etc.), and they are up-to-date and quite interesting: everybody should have an opinion on these issues. Almost all activities will be authentically communicative, encouraging students to listen and speak extensively (active learning!). Moreover, the textbook provides various useful tips for developing your listening, pronunciation, grammar, and conversational skills in English. The level is "intermediate", so it should be a good challenge. As well as studying the textbook, in each class we will do some supplementary communicative activities, including student presentations.</p>
