



Vision


An Internationally recognized institute in Liberal Arts and Sciences with an emphasis on GNH value based learning.

Sherubtse: Milestone

1968: Establishment of Sherubtse Public School.

1976: Introduction of Junior College – Higher Secondary.

1978: School section moved to Khaling.

1983: Introduction of Degree courses in Arts, Commerce and General Science under the aegis of the University of Delhi (DU).

2003: Royal University of Bhutan (RUB) was established and Sherubtse became a constituent college.


2006: Sherubtse College started offering degree programmes under the Royal University of Bhutan in Arts/ Science/ Commerce.

2008: Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of Commerce degree programmes were shifted to Gedu College of Business Studies.

2021: BSc in Data Science and BSc in Statistics programmes were introduced in the Department of Mathematical Sciences

Sherubtse Student Leadership Programme

Faculty members from Sherubtse College with support from Renaissance College, University of New Brunswick, Canada, developed the course.

The course focuses on development of key aspects of leadership skills such as motivation, problem solving, and team building, to mention a few. Since 2009, the programme has catered to over 1000 Sherubtse students.

Every semester, Sherubtse Student Leadership Programme (SSLP) organizes leadership course for the students to develop and groom the leadership qualities in them.

Students are selected based on the information provided in the SSLP form and number of participants are set by the SSLP team members.

SSLP is a semester long Leadership Certificate programme.

Ongoing Externally Funded Research Projects

Following are the ongoing externally funded research projects carried out by the college.

1. South Asian Nitrogen Hub funded by UKRI-GCRF
2. A communication education programme to curb direct pollution of amphibian breeding sites in eastern Bhutan funded by Rufford Foundation
3. Assessment of population, habitat and threats *Cycas pectinate*, a vulnerable taxon in Bhutan funded by Rufford Foundation
4. Understanding of Source Waters and Recharge Mechanism of Mountain Springs and Streams in Radhi and Phongmey Gewogs in Trashigang, Bhutan Himalaya funded PEER
5. Rivers in Bhutan: Enhancing capacities for monitoring of biodiversity and ecosystem services funded by APPEAR
6. Building Capacity to Improve Air Quality in South Asia: Reducing PM_{2.5} Through Low-Cost Sensor Network Driven Policy Decisions
