Students should have personal international insurance that can cover the students' medical fee in Korea from the date of arrival until the end of March.

## <Information About Quarantine Procedures>

\* Please note that the information below is based on the current semester(2020 Fall), and this procedure may change due to the situation of COVID19 at the time of your students' arrival

### *1. Arrival Procedure*

- Currently, Gimhae International Airport is closed and foreigners are not allowed to take domestic flight. Therefore, your student should come to Korea through Incheon Airport. Once students arrive Incheon airport, they will have to move to Gwangmyung station to take KTX train to Busan Station.
- Once students arrive Busan station, our staff will be waiting for the students at the station. The students will have to have COVID19 test once they come out of the station and after the test is done, they will be moved to our quarantine facility which will be one of our dormitories (Seokdang Global House).
- \* For us to meet your students in Busan station, it is crucial for students to contact me via Kakaotalk (id: briankay86). Therefore, please inform the students that they must inform me about their train departure time to Busan once they buy the KTX tickets.**
- \* Students will be transferred via minivan from Busan Station to the quarantine facility.**

### *2. Quarantine Fee*

- Students will be quarantined for 14 days and be responsible for their own quarantine fee
- Quarantine room fee: **182,000 KRW**
- Food: **210,000 KRW (3 meals/day)**
- Pillow & Blanket rental: **15,000 KRW (for 14 days)**
- \* If students have any special dietary requirements such as being Muslim, vegetarian and etc., please let us know in advance.**
- There may be a slight change in the quarantine fee by the time students arrive Busan.**
