<b>NOMINATION AND APPLICATION</b>	<p><b>NOMINATION DEADLINE:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Winter semester and whole academic year: 30 April 2023</li> <li>• Summer semester: 30 October 2023</li> </ul> <p>Partner university nominates their students to the JU and sends their nomination to JU exchange coordinators.</p> <p><b>APPLICATIONS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Winter semester and whole academic year: 1-31 May 2023</li> <li>• Summer semester: 1-30 November 2023</li> </ul> <p>Nominated students have to register via MyMobility: <a href="#">HERE</a></p> <p>Students select "Bilateral exchange" and needs to register and complete the online application form.  This application form should be filled out, printed, signed by coordinator of the home university, and uploaded to mymobility system.</p> <p>Documents to be uploaded:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Application Form (generated in the portal)</li> <li>2. Motivation Letter</li> <li>3. Language Certificate</li> <li>4. Transcript of Records</li> <li>5. <b>COURSES RESTRICTED</b>	<p>Courses at Collegium Medicum and courses at the School of Polish Language and Culture that have budget autonomy.  Limited access to the courses at the Institute of English Studies.</p>

<b>REGISTRATION FOR COURSES – DIFFERENT OPTIONS</b>	<p>Registration for courses opens at the beginning of the semester. We advise students to check the exact dates of registration in the registration calendar in USOSweb (available on the left).</p> <p>It is suggested to register as soon as possible, since courses have limited number of places.</p> <p>Rules of registration vary from institute to institute, therefore we suggest checking in the list of courses which rules apply for a particular course.</p> <p><b>Online registration</b> in USOSweb.</p> <p>After registering for a course in USOSweb, students should link the course to the correct stage (ER - International Students Office).</p> <p><u><a href="#">Instructions to USOSweb are available here.</a></u></p> <p>Registration in the secretary office of the institute/faculty that offers the course. (applicable if online registration for the course is not available).</p> <p>Via e-mail to the coordinator of the course (this type of registration will be defined in the list of courses file).</p>
