### Application Deadlines

All undergraduate and graduate application materials must be received by the following dates in order to be considered for admission:

Program	Fall	Spring	Summer
Undergraduate	July 30	December 1	April 30
Graduate	June 15	October 15	March 15

### Application Process

All students should go to the following link to apply. Students first need to create an account and then after creating the account sign in and complete the application.

The online application asks applicants to upload their supporting documents (transcripts, passport copy, test scores (if applicable), and their financial support document.)

The application can be done over time as one can always sign back in to complete parts that are still required.

Students will still need to provide original documents by bringing them to campus in August.

### **Course Registration**

As an exchange student, you will be assigned an academic advisor who will help you in registering for your courses. In most cases, this is done upon arrival at Findlay at the beginning of the term.

Exchange students that have the requisite English skill can take courses in most departments. Some courses do have pre-requisites.

### **Housing**

Housing for exchange students is secured through an online process. Applying to housing happens after a student is accepted into the University of Findlay and has a student ID number. This number is shared with students once they are accepted (see below).

There are many different types of housing on campus with various costs. The breakdowns of costs for this past academic year were the following:

Double Room Residence Hall	\$2,425 per sem
Double Room Haven/Village/Special Interest House	\$2,670 per sem
Single Room: Residence Hall	\$3,195 per sem
Single Room: Haven/Village/Special Interest House	\$3,515 per sem
Single Room: Townhouse/Cottage/Oiler Pointe/Derrick Square	\$3,835 per sem

## **Housing Registration**

### **First Step: Register for Account**

1. Type housing.findlay.edu into your web browser. We recommend using Firefox or Google Chrome because Internet Explorer is not as compatible with Simple Campus Housing.
2. You are now on the homepage and need to sign-up for a Simple Campus account.
3. To begin click on the “Sign Up” box below the login box.
4. Now you fill in your information:
  - ID number. (You will receive your UF ID in your acceptance letter which will come with your I-20.)
  - Last name.
5. Email and password
6. Now click on the Create Account button and you will be ready to go!

Login in to your Simple Campus account and fill-out the following information:

Page 1: Student Information and Emergency Contact Info

Page 2: Life Style Preferences

Page 3: Meal Plan Selection (you can change these once you arrive at UF.)

Plans 1-3 are full meal plans. If you are living in the dorms, you are required to choose one of these.

Plan 4 is only available to those living in cottages, townhouses, Oiler Pointe, Derrick’s Square, a special interest house or a group house.

If you are living in cottages, townhouses, Oiler Pointe, Derrick’s Square, a special interest house or a group house you do have the option to have no meal plan at all. Please contact Student Affairs

once your assignment is finalized if you would like to choose this option.

Page 4: Housing contract - Please take your time to read this in its entirety. By clicking on **accept**, you are agreeing to abide by all terms and regulations in the contract.

### **Meal Plans**

Students that are living in dormitories are required to have a meal plan. The cost per semester is currently \$2,435/semester

Students that are housed in a on campus house with a kitchen can waive the meal plan.

### **International Insurance**

Health care costs in the United States are quite expensive. **It is required that all exchange students bring comprehensive coverage that can provide for medical emergencies, including emergency medical evacuation and repatriation of remains coverage.** A copy of the primary insurance coverage documents should be provided to Jenn Butler in the Buford Center upon arrival to campus.

In the event on non-emergency health care needs, the on-campus Cosiano Health Center is a free, walk-in clinic devoted to providing health care for University of Findlay students. Any student, regardless of insurance status, may use the clinic's services. Free services include general health assessments, over-the-counter medications, and various diagnostic tests, as well as first aid and wound care. The Center also offers a variety of immunizations at cost.

### **Arrival into Findlay**

The Buford Center for Diversity and Service will arrange a free pick-up for exchange students at Detroit Metropolitan Airport (DTW). Please send your flight details to Jenn Butler (butler@findlay.edu), Program Coordinator, in the Buford Center as soon as they are finalized. Since orientation begins on Thursday, August 16, **we suggest you arrive into DTW on Tuesday, August 14. We will only be able to arrange pick up on the 14<sup>th</sup>. If you arrive on another day, you will be responsible for getting from the airport to Findlay.**

### **Orientation**

The International Admissions and Immigration Services office will provide an orientation for all new international students starting on Thursday, August 16.
