Individual Faculty may require other standards.</p> <p>Students may be required to demonstrate the capacity to manage upper-level courses (by submitting a transcript showing completion of specified pre-requisite courses or otherwise showing academic competencies). SAT scores are required for admission to some degree programs.</p>

Visa Regulations: Do students need a visa upon their arrival?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Please apply from your home country at a Thai Embassy or Consulate. ➤ The THAILAND Non-immigrant ED-Visa is required to study. ➤ Students who arrive without the ED-Visa may seek assistance from the ISC Office.
Health Insurance:	**All international students must have Medical/Health and Accident Insurance covering the duration of their studies in Thailand. If students do not have health insurance prior to arrival, they must apply at the International Studies Center (ISC) immediately upon arrival (est. 8,500 THB per year).
Estimated Living Expenses:	Approximately 15,000-20,000 THB per month (5 months per semester)
