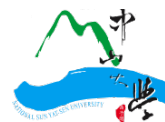

Areas of Study Open for EXCHANGE Students

All fields are open to exchange students as long as the student has adequate Chinese proficiency. Otherwise, students can only take courses offered in English. Some master courses are not open to bachelor students.

Credit and Grading System

Every 18 hours is counted as 1 credit. For example, if the total class hour during a semester is 54 hours, the course is a 3-credits course.

Chinese Language Courses

Students who have learned Chinese before and wish to enroll in Mandarin courses are required to take a placement test upon arrival. The Chinese Language Center will arrange the students to appropriate levels according to the test result.

*Please note that we offer 4hrs Mandarin courses freely per week for exchange students; the course is a 3-credits course. **Students must apply for the Mandarin course at time of exchange program application.***

Visa

All students must apply Visitor/Resident Visa to enter Taiwan with their admission letter. After their entry to Taiwan, students need to extend the visa for another 60/90 days prior to the expiration of the visa. As for the students staying for a full academic year, they must obtain a Resident Visa to enter Taiwan, and they are required to apply for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) within 15 days after their arrival.

Health check-up

All students must take a medical check-up before arrival. One semester students are required to take the **C form medical check-up** and a copy of the report must be submitted upon registration. One-year students are required to take the **B form medical check-up** in order to apply for a Resident Visa to enter Taiwan.

Arrival and Orientation

Students should arrive at NSYSU 4 days before the class begins.

The orientation normally takes place on the Friday before registration date and is mandatory for all exchange students.



Health Insurance and Facilities

All exchange students are required to join the NSYSU Student Group Insurance.

Students staying for one academic year are required to join the National Health Insurance, starting the 6th month they receive their Alien Resident Certificate.

Health Facilities at the University: Family Medicine Clinic and Dental Clinic

Costs

Housing: NT\$17,000 (International Dorm - 2 people share a room)

NT\$8,500 (Local Dorm - 4 people share a room) per semester

Housing (Off campus): NT8,000 - 12,000/ per month

Meals: NT\$8,000-9,000 per month

Books: NT\$5,000 per semester

Local transportation: NT\$3,000 per month

Health insurance: NT\$326 per semester (NSYSU student group insurance)

Internet: NT\$300 per semester

NT\$749 per month (National Health Insurance—for students staying for one academic year only – obligated to join starting at the 6th month)

Note: The estimation is the **average** spending of a typical student attending NSYSU.

Additional Fees to Pay

Winter dormitory fee: NT\$4,300

Summer dormitory fee: NT\$8,600

Fees are subject to change each year.
