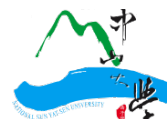
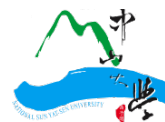

## Courses

### Course Selection

There are several course selection phases in each semester. The first online selection will start two weeks before class begins.

### Areas of Study Open for EXCHANGE Students

All fields are open to exchange students as long as the student has adequate Chinese proficiency. Otherwise, students can only take courses offered in English. Students are allowed to choose courses from different departments/colleges and levels. Some graduate level courses are not open to undergraduate students.

### Credit and Grading System

Every 18 hours is counted as 1 credit. If the total class hour during a semester is 54 hours, the course will be a 3-credits course.

## Chinese Language Courses

*We offer 4hrs Mandarin courses per week without charge for exchange students; the course is a 3-credits course. **Students must apply for the Chinese language course at time of exchange program application.***

Students who have learned Chinese before and wish to enroll in Chinese language course are required to take a placement test upon arrival. The Chinese Language Center will arrange students to appropriate levels according to the test result.

### Dormitory Application Deadline(s):

Same as the exchange program application deadline. No cancellation after the application period.

## Visa

All students must apply Visitor/Resident Visa to enter Taiwan with their admission letter. After their entry to Taiwan, students need to extend the visa for another 60/90 days prior to the expiration date. For students staying for a full academic year, they must obtain a Resident Visa to enter Taiwan, and they are required to apply for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) within 15 days after their arrival.

## Health Examination

**All students must take a medical examination before arrival.** One-semester students are required to take the **C form medical check-up** and a copy of the report must be submitted upon registration. One-year students are required to take the **B form medical check-up** in order to apply for a Resident Visa to enter Taiwan.

## Arrival and Orientation

Students should arrive at NSYSU 4 days before the class begins.

The orientation and the campus tour are usually held on the Friday before class begins and they are mandatory for all exchange students to attend.





## Health Insurance and Facilities

All exchange students are required to join the NSYSU Student Group Insurance and purchase travel insurance with medical and accident policies before their arrival.

Students staying for one academic year are required to join the National Health Insurance, starting from the 6<sup>th</sup> month they receive their Alien Resident Certificate.

## Costs

**On-Campus Housing:** International Dorm - NT\$17,000 per semester

Local Dorm - NT\$8,500 per semester

**Off-Campus Housing:** NT5,000 - 10,000 per month

**Meals:** NT\$8,000-9,000 per month

**Books:** NT\$5,000 per semester

**Local Transportation:** NT\$1,500 per month

**Health Insurance:** NT\$326 per semester (NSYSU Student Group Insurance)

**Internet:** NT\$300 per semester

National Health Insurance: NT\$749 per month (obligated to join for students who continuously stay in Taiwan for 6 months)

Estimated cost per month: 270USD – 350USD

**Note:** The estimation is the **average** spending of a typical student attending NSYSU.

### Additional Fees to Pay

International Dorm : Winter dormitory fee: NT\$4,300 / Summer dormitory fee: NT\$8,600

Local Dorm : Winter dormitory fee: NT\$2,100 / Summer dormitory fee: NT\$4,300

Fees are subject to change.
