- 2. Official Historical Academic Transcript issued by Home University (must contain GPA and please provide the grading system of the school)
- 3. Letter of Recommendation
- 4. Copy of Information Page of Passport
- Head Photo: it should be in JPEG file and followed by the passport photo standard
- \*All the documents should be written in **English** or Chinese.
- \*Please note that the departments in the school of Management expects applicants to have 4 GPA (scale 5) and have taken at least 2 management related courses.
- \*Please make sure the programs students apply for match their majors.
