

入学料徴収猶予制度について

(学部入学者及び編入学者:私費外国人留学生用)

私費外国人留学生の学部入学者及び編入学者を対象とした、入学料徴収猶予制度のご案内です。

申請を希望する方は、入学手続き時は入学料を納入せず、必要書類を文京キャンパスの学生は入試課、松岡キャンパスの学生は松岡キャンパス学務課へ提出してください。申請の詳細は、「申請手続きの流れ」をご確認ください。

・ 大学独自の入学料徴収猶予制度

下記のいずれかに該当する場合、本人の申請に基づき、選考のうえ、入学月から6ヶ月を超えない範囲で一定期間、入学料の徴収を猶予する制度です。

- ・ 入学前1年以内において、入学する者の学資を主として負担している者(学資負担者)が死亡した場合
- ・ 入学前1年以内において、入学する者又は学資負担者が日本国内で風水害等の災害を受けた場合
- ・ 学長が相当と認める理由がある場合(学資負担者失職{自己都合退職、定年退職を除く})

◇ 選考対象外となる方

- ・ 国費外国人留学生
- ・ 政府派遣外国人留学生
- ・ 研究生及び科目等履修生
- ・ 既に入学料を納入している方
- ・ 選考結果が判明するまでに退学願又は休学願を提出した方

※ 在留資格等が特定特別永住者、永住者、日本人の配偶者等、永住者の配偶者等、定住者、家族滞在の方は、国の高等教育の修学支援新制度に申請できる可能性がありますので、日本人学生用の制度概要をご確認ください。

◇ 備考

- ・ 「免除」ではないため、許可された場合でも、猶予期限までに納入する必要があります。
- ・ 家計及び学力基準により、全ての申請を許可できるものではありません。

Admission Fee Collection Deferral Program

(For undergraduate entrants, transfer students, and privately financed international students)

This is the information about the admission fee collection deferral program for privately-financed international students entering undergraduate programs or transferring into the university.

If you wish to apply, **do not pay the admission fee during the admission procedures.** Instead, students at the Bunkyo Campus should submit the required documents to the Admissions Division, while students at the Matsuoka Campus should submit them to the Academic Affairs Division for Matsuoka Campus. For details on the application process, please refer to the section "**Application Procedure Flow for privately-financed international students.**"

Admission Fee Collection Deferral

If you meet **any of the following conditions**, you may apply for a deferment of the admission fee. After screening, the payment of the admission fee may be deferred for up to **six months from the month of enrollment.**

✧ Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet one of the following conditions:

- If the person who mainly supported the student's educational expenses (financial supporter) **passed away within one year before enrollment.**
- If the applicant or their financial supporter **have been damaged by a natural disaster** (such as floods, storms, etc.) **in Japan within one year before enrollment.**
- If the applicant has any valid reason deemed by the president, such as the **loss of employment of the financial supporter** (excluding voluntary resignation or mandatory retirement).

✧ Applicants Not Eligible for Consideration

- Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship students
- Government-sponsored international students
- Research students and non-degree students
- Those who have already paid the admission fee.
- Those who submit a withdrawal or leave-of-absence request before the screening results are announced.

Note:

If your residence status is one of the following you may be eligible for Japan's higher education student support program. Please refer to the information for Japanese students.

- Special Permanent Resident
- Permanent Resident
- Spouse or Child of a Japanese National
- Spouse or Child of a Permanent Resident
- Long-Term Resident
- Dependent

✧ Important Notes

- This is a **deferment, not a waiver/exemption**. Even if you are approved, you must pay the enrollment fee by the specified deferment deadline.
- Approval is not guaranteed. Applications are evaluated based on household financial circumstances and academic performance.
