Visa

You must apply for a valid visa (Visitor or Resident Visa) in your country of residence BEFORE entering Taiwan. As there is no "Student Visa" for international students studying in Taiwan, students whose exchange period is more than 180 days may apply for Resident Visas or for extendable Visitor Visas if the exchange period is less than 180 days.

Insurance

Students are required to have sufficient medical and accident coverage for the first four months or the semester they stay in Taiwan.

Upon Arrival

Foreign Students that have applied for resident visas have to apply for insurance covering the first months of their stay. After six months the students will be transferred to national health insurance. Students that only stay for one semester need to check whether the domestic insurance covers any cost made in Taiwan.

Insurance fee's

Initial six month coverage at USD102.

After six months national health insurance at USD152 a half year.

Rooms

In the area surrounding the university there is a wide range of student rooms available. Contracts for the student rooms have a minimum rental period time of 6 months. The rental fee has to be paid at the start of the contract with prices ranging from USD 650 to USD 915. The rental fee does not include utilities they need to be paid each month or every two months. Almost all rooms are furnished and have their own bathroom, toilet and internet connection. Within the student house there is communal water dispenser and washing machine.

Apartments

There are some apartments for rent in the vicinity of the university. The minimum contract length for an apartment is one year. Most apartments are furnished, but internet and cable connection need to be arranged.

Chinese classes

Free Chinese Courses for all of YunTech's international students:

Yuntech provides its exchange student with free Chinese classes. All of the classes are 36 hours in total. Classes take place 2 times a week for 2 hours.

Basic Chinese

The course is designed to improve students' proficiency of listening, speaking and reading Chinese. It offers various situations where students have chances to speak Chinese and learn to deal with various situations in Chinese. The basic conversations and vocabulary used for daily life will be discussed and practiced. The course also involves story reading through which students can improve their Chinese reading abilities. The whole learning environment will be pleasant and enjoyable.

Intermediate Chinese

This course is designed for students who have learned Chinese for a period of time to further develop language skills. At the intermediate level, a greater proportion of class time is devoted to developing reading and speaking skills. Class discussions are emphasized and give students an opportunity to further utilize their Chinese in a wide variety of situations. Meanwhile, students are given greater freedom to express their opinions. Class debates and discussions are used to broaden students' range of vocabulary, and various readings help students to develop expertise in subjects they are interested in. The study of materials, therefore, will focus on articles and papers retrieved from appropriate magazines, newspapers, and web sites.



Food

From Airport to Yuntech

Airport Pick Up Service

We arrange an airport pick up service from Taiwan Taoyuan or Kaohsiung International Airport to YunTech to ensure your safe arrival. If you need the shuttle service, please fill out the form [Airport Pick Up Service Form] and email or fax us more than a week in advance and we will make the proper arrangements.

From Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport

Yuntech understands that you may want to make your own arrangements, listed below are directions to get to the Yuntech main gate and on-campus dormitories.

** We strongly suggest you arrive in Taiwan during the day to avoid missing the trains.



Step 1: By Bus (From Taoyuan International Airport to Taichung-Taichung train station)

There is no direct train or bus travelling from the airport to Yuntech. Bus tickets are available at both Terminals (Terminal 1: on the southeast side; Terminal 2: on the northeast side). There are several bus companies that run to Taichung City Train Station.

Step 2: By Train (From Taichung to Douliou City)

Yuntech is located in Douliou City. When you arrive at Taichung Train Station, you can take the train to Douliou city. There are three different kinds of trains: Tze-Chiang (Fastest), Chu-Kuang (Medium), Local Train

Step 3: By Taxi (From Douliou Train Station to Yuntech Main Gate/Dorm)

A taxi can be found in front of the train station.

2. By Shuttle bus + High Speed Rail (HSR) + Train + Taxi (Travel Time: approximately 2hrs 15 mins)

Step 1: By shuttle bus (From Taoyuan International Airport to Taoyuan HSR station)

Tickets are sold at the following locations:

- (1) Taoyuan Airport: UBUS service counters at Arrivals Lobby of Terminals 1 and 2.
- (2) THSR Taoyuan Station: platform 1 at bus depot.
- (3) Intervals: 5 10 minutes intervals during peak times.

Step 2: By HSR (From Taoyuan HSR station to Taichung – Xin Wu Ri station)

Intervals: 30 minutes

Step 3: By Train (From Taichung-Xin Wu Ri station to Douliou city)

There are two different kinds of trains: Chu-Kuang (Medium), Local Train

Step 4: By Taxi (From Douliou Train Station to Yuntech Main Gate/Dorm)

A taxi can be found in front of the train station.
