




QUICK FACTS


- Subtropical monsoon climate





BANK ACCOUNT INFORMATION

REGISTERING BANK ACCOUNT

When opening a bank account, foreigners should present a valid passport and an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC).

If you have stipend supporting from university, you should register for the Far Eastern International Bank (FEIB) Bank account, otherwise, you can register for other Bank outside school.

For Far Eastern International Bank registering:

There is a FEIB office in building 5, first floor, next to the Family Mart store. It's open for Bank Account registering on Tuesday and Thursday. It takes I week to get your ATM card.



For other bank registering:

You can directly come to bank office near school for registering.

Select your Bank account code or type in the Textbox (805 for FEIB) \rightarrow Type the Bank Account number in the below textbox \rightarrow Click Save.














桃園客運「【155】中壢-元智大學」調整後市區公車路線圖

VISA INFORMATION

Resident Visa \to ARC (within 15 days after entering Taiwan) Visitor Visa (Visa upon arrival) \to Resident Visa \to ARC (within 15 days after entering Taiwan).

All new students (including Visa-free countries) MUST apply for a Resident Visa before entering Taiwan. If you failed to do so, you would still need to change the Visitor Visa into Resident Visa before applying for ARC

ARC serves as your ID card in Taiwan. GAO will assist in applying for the ARC card during your first semester.

ALIEN RESIDENT CERTIFICATE (ARC)

ARC serves as your ID card in Taiwan. GAO will assist in applying for the ARC card during your first semester. Application Fee: NT\$ 1,000

Students are responsible to renew the ARC card every year.

RENEWAL OF ARC

If your ARC will expire while you are abroad during winter or summer break, please renew your ARC before you leave Taiwan. Apart from the required documents listed above, you need to bring your round trip E-ticket/Flight Itinerary as supporting document for the National Immigration Agency. The receipt issued by the National Immigration Agency can be used as your re-entry permit to enter Taiwan if you do not receive the ARC card before your departure.

CHANGE OF INFORMATION

If you have any update of information such as changing of address or passport number, please visit the National Immigration Agency to apply for "information change" with the original and photocopy of the document that has the information that needed to be changed within 15 days to avoid penalty. No fee will be charged if the application of information change is applied within 15 days. The penalty of late application will be NT\$ 2,000-10,000.

LOST OF ARC

Lost ARC in Taiwan: Report immediately to your nearest police station. You will be issued a "Statement of Lost ARC" from the police station. Take the statement to the nearest National Immigration Agency to apply for a replaced ARC card. The fee is NT\$ 500.

Lost of ARC abroad: If you are from countries that are eligible for the visa exemption program, you can enter Taiwan by Visa on Landing. If you need a visa to enter Taiwan, please apply for a resident visa abroad to enter Taiwan. After you enter Taiwan, please follow the instruction as "Lost in ARC in Taiwan".



WORKING PERMIT

For the international students who wish to work in Taiwan (either on campus or off campus), you are required to apply for and obtain the work permit before starting work.



WORKING PERMIT REGULATIONS

- It is stipulated that student's working hours per week should not exceed more than 20 hours except for the winter and summer vacation.
- In the permitted duration, the work permit should be returned due to leave from school or drop.
- If you hold a job without applying for the work permit, you may be fined for NT\$30,000 to NT\$150,000 and ordered to leave the country immediately.

- Passport Page (PLEASE DON'T UPLOAD VISA PAGE)
- Student ID with register stamp or enrollment certificate
- 3. Alien Resident Certificate (ARC)
- 4. Postal Giro Rankin Slips

Before you submit the application form, please come to GAO and get the POSTAL GIRO RANKIN SLIPS. The receipt of the fee transfer from the post office (the amount is NT\$100). You may transfer the application fee to the out campus post office.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE

- NHI Insurance Program is a compulsory social insurance program. It is founded on the concept of
 mutual assistance and depends on the insured paying their premium. By law, every Taiwanese
 citizen with official residency or foreign national living in Taiwan with an ARC MUST enroll in the
 program. No one may arbitrarily withdraw, except for those who lose their insurance eligibility
 such as people who give up their Taiwan citizenship, move abroad, or let their ARC expire.
- The premium of NHI will be included in your Tuition Fee Payment Slip every semester when you are eligible to join the NHI program. The premium is NT\$ 826 per month, hence the payment per semester is NT\$ 4.956.
- Before joining the NHI program, GAO will help all newly arrived students to join a commercial
 insurance program with a cost of NT\$ 500 per month. GAO will inform you to pick-up your NHI
 card by YZO student mail once we receive it.

- If you lost/damaged your NHI IC card please submit the documents below to GAO and we will help you to apply for a replacement card.
- Scholarship recipient (such as YZU scholarship) with tuition waiver must pay the NHI fee each semester to the cashier because tuition waiver does not include NHI fee.

CATHY LIFE INSURANCE GROUP STUDENTS HEALTH INSURANCE

According to the National Health Insurance (NHI) Act, all foreigners staying in Taiwan for more than six months and meet criteria must join the NHI program. To ensure all international students are covered by a medical insurance before joining National Health Insurance (NHI), GAO will help all international students to buy commercial medical insurance (Cathay Life Insurance Group Students Health Insurance) for the first six months.

What documents you need to prepare

- 1. Diagnosis (Original File)
- 2. Payment Receipt (Original File)
- 3. ARC and Passport (Copy)
- 4. Bank account cover page (Copy)



SCOOTER IN TAIWAN

Licenses in Taiwan

To drive legally in the long run, you'll need a Taiwan license. If you only want to drive a 50cc scooter, you'll only need to take a written exam. To get a scooter license for scooters from 51-250cc, you'll need to take a written and a driving test, you will have to locate a DMV in Taiwan. There is a written part on the exam and a driving test. An interesting example for the writing test is available in English. The writing section is available in English and you can preview this exam online. The driving section of the exam involves driving down a straight line with a timer and touch-sensitive barriers, and some stopping. You'll get two tries for the driving section of the exam. This license allows you to drive scooters from 50-249cc.

Buying a Scooter

To buy a scooter in Taiwan, you can opt to buy from an out-going foreigner or a scooter shop. If you choose the latter, you'll definitely need your ARC (Alien Resident Certificate), though you do not, ironically, need a license to own a scooter. Buying from an outgoing foreigner will be your best deal, as you can expect the price to be up to 50% less, more if you can haggle well: remember, their leaving Taiwan for good.

Insurance

Taiwan has no-fault insurance, and that means everyone must have a minimum level of insurance. If you get into an accident, everyone is covered medically for up to 200,000NT. Compulsory damages, such as if you hit a house or another car, repairs and such, you will be liable for. You can get policies for this type of thing, but most don't. Drive Carefully.

Licences Required Docuements


If you're planning on staying in Taiwan for more than a year, the benefits of having a local license vastly outweigh the tiny bit of extra legwork you'll have to do to get one. A general heavy motorcycle licence is valid for six years, and you'll be eligible to take the large heavy motorcycle licence should you wish after one year.

- 1. An Alien Residence Certificate (ARC) with total validity of over six months
- 2. A completed application form (available at the office)
- 3. Three 1-inch licence photos taken within the past 6 months
- 4. A medical evaluation
- 5.NT\$200

After completing driver's ed you'll be able to take the theory test, which has 50 questions consisting of:

- 30 multiple-choice on rules, road signs, and situations
- 20 true/false on rules and road signs
